Bland County Historical Society Memorial Scholarship

Her passing prompted a suggestion for a memorial scholarship in her name as well as that of **Zareda Earnest**, a founding member and longtime president. These two women worked diligently to organize and maintain the Bland County Historical Society from its inception in 1988. The purpose of the Historical Society is to help educate the community about our Bland History and so acting upon this suggestion the Board of Directors voted at their January meeting to pursue setting up a scholarship for a graduating senior at Bland County High School with an interest and demonstrated ability in history. We will be seeking donations for this scholarship from our members as well as the community at large. Details of the scholarship are currently being developed with input from the Bland County High School.

- Since this is a historical calendar, please try to write a short description of the event and the history of the event. As we did in the 2016 calendar, we will try the historical background of the events included in the 2017 calendar.
- The photographs must have been taken during the past five years (2012-2016).
- This year we will only be accepting digital images. No prints, please. Send to info@blandcountyhistsoc.org
- We request that you submit pictures as they were taken. No "photoshoping," no filters or other enhancements.
- We will begin accepting pictures on or after March 1, 2016. No pictures accepted after July 15, 2016.
- If we have enough entries, voting will take place from July 16 August 15, 2016. The Calendars will be ready at the 2016 Festival of Leaves in October.
