#### FALLEN HEROES PROJECT

It is with a sense of pride that we can report that the Bland County Historical Society has completed the project that we began following a request from the staff of the Virginia War Memorial in Richmond, VA. The request was for Bland County information "to build a database of photos and brief biographies on all the soldiers on the Shrine Wall who died while wearing the uniform of the U. S. Military, beginning with World War II forward."

The Board of Directors accepted that challenge and with the guidance of Ann Beardshall, a group of members began researching the lives of those Bland County men who were identified on the War Memorial as well as checking with various other sources. The family stories we gathered, the photos, and the information about the places they served and died have all had an emotional impact on us.

Besides the requested information we also chose to collect this information on World War I soldiers who died during the conflict. Military members who died during Korea, Vietnam, and the Cold War are also included.

We are sharing all this information with Bland County people through the Fallen Heroes Display which has been exhibited in the Historical Society Office for several months. We are indebted to the American Legion Post 20 for lending us its collection of photographs of the men who died in World War II.

In addition, the Display was shown at our Festival of Leaves Booth in October. Ann Beardshall has presented the information to a number of organizations, including a presentation of the WWI Fallen Heroes at the Historical Society Meeting in June, to the American Legion Post 20 at the Veterans Day Celebration in November sponsored by the American Legion Auxiliary, to the Bland County Retired Teachers November Meeting, and recently to the Stuart-Wilderness Road Daughters of the American Revolution.

As the final result of all the information gathered, Ann Beardshall edited a book, containing most of the information that had been obtained by our various members. We also dedicated a commemorative 2018 calendar to this project highlighting the men from Bland County who died in these conflicts.

It has been an honor to learn of our Bland history through the men who gave their lives for their country. This project will remain a part of the archives of the Bland County Historical Society and available to anyone who wants to study and remember these brave men.

#### **FESTIVAL OF LEAVES 2017**

For the first time in several years the weather was beautiful and the crowds were larger and happier. Ann and Elmer Beardshall and Pat Turner decorated our booth in the Fair Display Building with pictures of Bland County's Fallen Heroes surrounded by red, white and blue. There was patriotic music in the background as well as a wonderful slide show featuring the men whose stories we have told in the calendar and book. We were proud to have so many veterans and families thank us for this moving project.

## BCHS 2<sup>ND</sup> ANNUAL CRUISE-IN
