Our student Cooperative Association has been an active organization in our school this year. Through the student Council there has been student participation in the government of the school and many activities which have meant school and student growth.

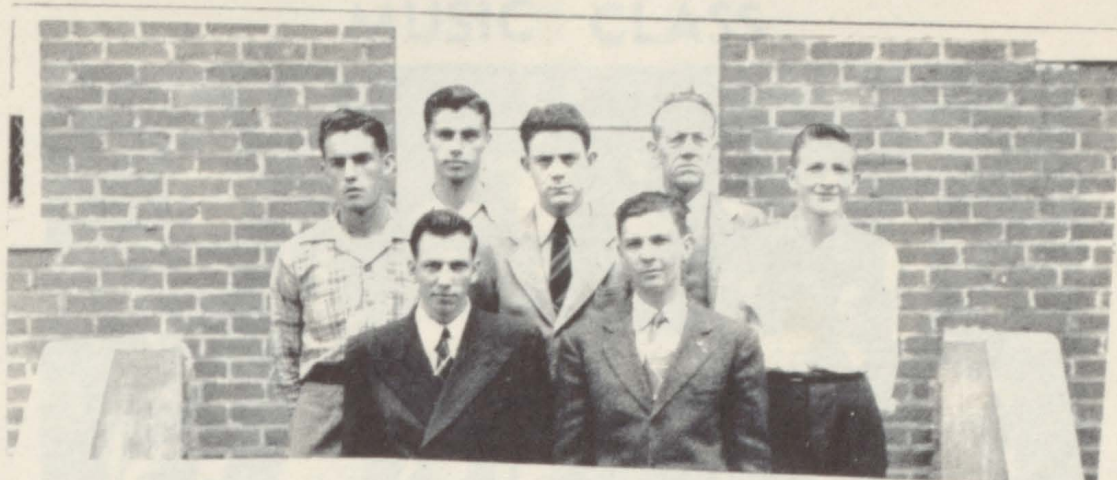
