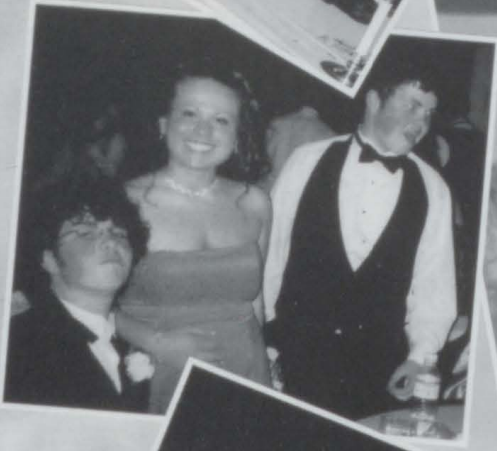
"Take My Breath Away" Bland H.S. Prom 2005
