One of our fellow students who was loved by all is Ronald Burge. Still residing in Ceres, he is the editor of the hometown newspaper, THE CERES STAR.

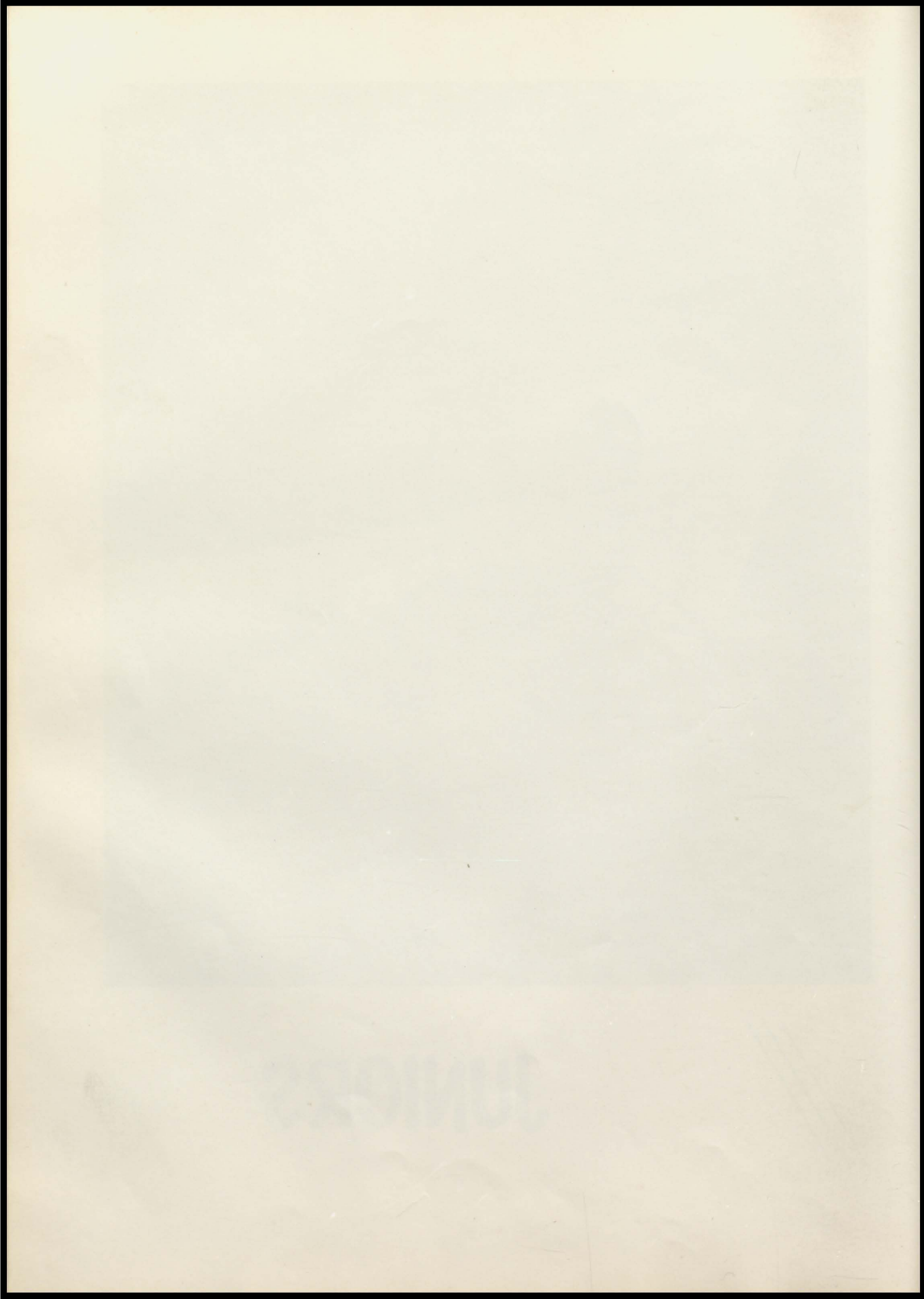
I, Johnny Scott, am now a vocational agriculture teacher at Ceres and have enrolled in my classes two hundred and fifty students--some increase since 1960.
