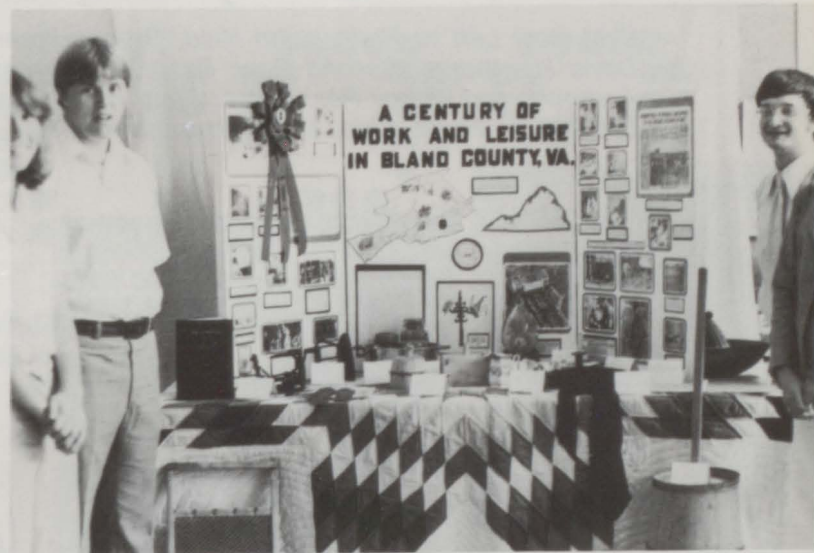




## Students In U. S. History Class Win State Award
