PRINCIPAL

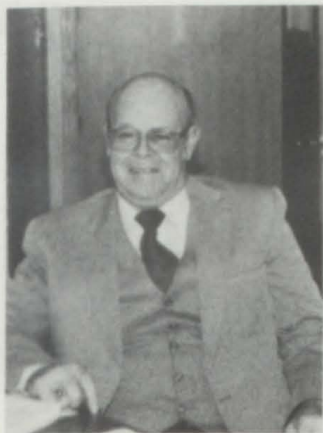
